- COSC planning event attended by Virginia and Mrs. Voth. Represented the school and the complexities of the school. How the Catholic faith was integrated into the school. Identity, optimal learning, complexity were the main areas being discussed by each school. Mental health in schools is a focus.
- Strike repercussions – there is a pacing guide regarding the content being taught. This has been readjusted, so that parts of the curriculum can be blended. This covers all subjects except for math – the new math curriculum is much more challenging than the previous one. So math will have to be ‘caught up’ on.
